Defining Sex as Male and Female

Original Bill: SB76 Amended Bill: **Sponsor:** Sen. Adam Schnelting (R)

Description: Modifies provision relating to prohibited discriminatory practices.

Position: Support

MCC Statement: No one should face unjust discrimination, including discrimination for same-sex attraction or gender dysphoria; however, interpreting sex discrimination to include sexual orientation and gender identity would have potentially negative implications for religious liberty, privacy rights, and rights of conscience. This bill makes clear that the definition of sex does not include sexual orientation and gender identity. 02/19/25

Immunity for Disclosure of Abuse by Employees

Original Bill: HB753 Amended Bill: Sponsor: Rep. Don Mayhew (R)

Description: Provides immunity from civil liability for disclosures by a charitable organization of allegations of sexual misconduct.

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MCC Statement: Non-profits should be immune from civil liability when disclosing to other non-profits incidents of abuse previously reported to the state, as required by law, about which the non-profit is a mandatory reporter. 01/17/25
