Description: Creates the offense of trespass by an illegal alien, which would make any undocumented immigrant who is apprehended by a bounty hunter or peace officer guilty of a felony punishable by imprisonment without eligibility for probation or parole. The bill also implements the "Missouri Illegal Alien Certified Bounty Hunter Program", which would certify applicants to be bounty hunters for the purpose of finding and detaining illegal aliens in the state. Additionally, the bill mandates an information system for people to report illegal aliens (toll-free telephone hotline, email, and online portal), rewarding them with \$1,000 for every person who is arrested.
