

Welcome and Accompany Immigrants and Refugees

Missouri Illegal Alien Certified Bounty Hunter Program

Original Bill: [SB480](#) **Amended Bill:** **Sponsor:** Sen. David Gregory (R)

Description: Creates criminal procedure provisions regarding the offense of trespass by an illegal alien. Legislation only goes into effect if SB 72 passes.

Position: Oppose

MCC Statement: Bill details some aspects of the Offense of Trespass by an Illegal Alien as created in SB 72. 01/17/25

Original Bill: [SB72](#) **Amended Bill:** **Sponsor:** Sen. David Gregory (R)

Description: Creates the offense of trespass by an illegal alien, which would make any undocumented immigrant who is apprehended by a bounty hunter or peace officer guilty of a felony punishable by imprisonment without eligibility for probation or parole. The bill also implements the "Missouri Illegal Alien Certified Bounty Hunter Program", which would certify applicants to be bounty hunters for the purpose of finding and detaining illegal aliens in the state. Additionally, the bill mandates an information system for people to report illegal aliens (toll-free telephone hotline, email, and online portal), rewarding them with \$1,000 for every person who is arrested.

Position: Oppose

MCC Statement: Bill would incentivize citizens to potentially profile and report immigrants to authorities. Also subjects an individual to life in prison for merely being undocumented in the state. 01/17/25

Modifies Fees/Expenses for Interpreter or Translator

Original Bill: [HB182](#) **Amended Bill:** **Sponsor:** Rep. Cameron Parker (R)

Description: Modifies provisions relating to fees and expenses for an interpreter or translator in certain proceedings.

Position: Support

MCC Statement: Currently, translator's fees and expenses in a criminal case are paid by the state. This bill allows such fees and expenses in any civil, juvenile, or criminal proceeding to be paid by the State so that individuals understand their rights. 01/17/25

Original Bill: [SB218](#) **Amended Bill:** HCS SS SB 218 **Sponsor:** Sen. Rusty Black (R)

Description: Modifies the provisions relating to the establishment of treatment courts by providing for a mental health treatment court.

Position: Support in part

Offense of Concealment or Inducement of an Illegal Alien

Original Bill: [SB114](#) **Amended Bill:** **Sponsor:** Sen. Rick Brattin (R)

Description: Creates the offense of concealment or inducement of an illegal alien.

Position: Oppose

MCC Statement: The Church acknowledges that countries have the right to regulate their borders and to control immigration, however, they must do so with justice and mercy. This type of bill has also been used to attack charities that provide food and shelter to migrants in other states. 01/17/25
